



• In one of the more exciting news pieces of the week, <u>Android Monero Wallet Monerujo released its latest update!</u> The new release, Monerujo: Glamorous Gunther is now available on Github or the Google Play Store. The new update features a completely revamped user-friendly design and interface. I recommend all Android users test out the latest version! Additionally, <u>xmrujo.com</u> was launched as well. The Merkle reported on the news.



- The Merkle reported on how Monero's multisignatures implementation has officially entered testing phase. A merge with the main code is imminent, although no official date has been announced yet.

- A new Stanford University, University College London, and Blockstream research paper titled "<u>Bulletproofs: Efficient Range Proofs for Confidential Transactions</u>" was released. The paper discusses the possibility for reduction in transaction sizes in cryptocurrencies such as Monero.
