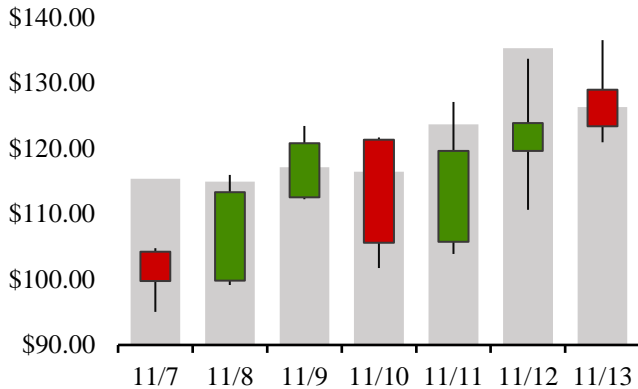

## THE LATEST

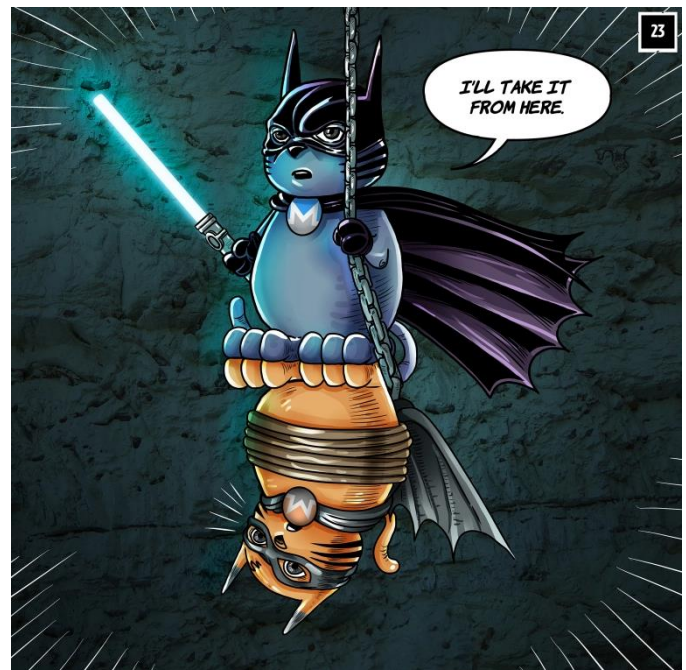
• Let's discuss cryptocurrency ETF's. There has previously been a lot of speculation in regards to whether the SEC would ever approve cryptocurrency ETF's as to date it has continuously rejected each one. The rationale for the rejections was that the underlying securities (cryptocurrencies) underlying the ETF's traded on unregulated exchanges. This all changed when the CME announced that they are launching cryptocurrency futures. It now appears cryptocurrency ETF's could now be given the stamp of approval because the underlying securities will now trade on regulated futures exchanges. Once ETF's are approved, we could see the floodgates open as institutional investors and mom and pop retail investors will now have direct access to cryptocurrencies.

What does this mean for Monero? VanEck, the world's ninth largest ETF provider with ~\$25bn in assets was [quick to launch 16 cryptocurrency indexes](#). It's clear that Bitcoin will not be the only beneficiary of ETF's as Monero is included in 5 of these indexes, and these indexes could eventually become ETF's of their own once approved. Monero is currently included in the MVIS CryptoCompare Digital Assets 100 Index, 100 Large-Cap Index, 10 Index, 25 Index, and its very own Monero index.

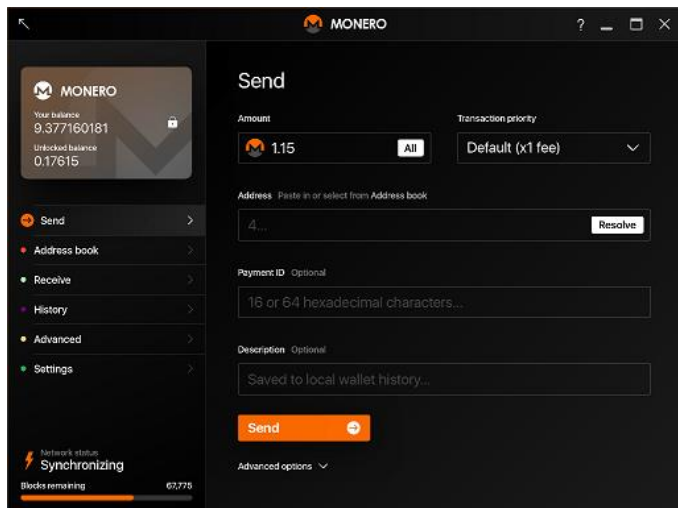
- There was an update on the custom monero hardware wallet. There is now a working base edition prototype! [See reddit for discussion](#).

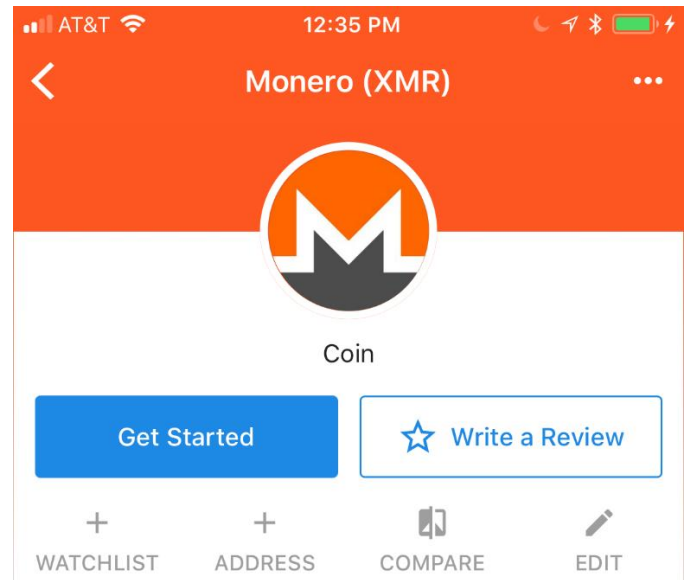

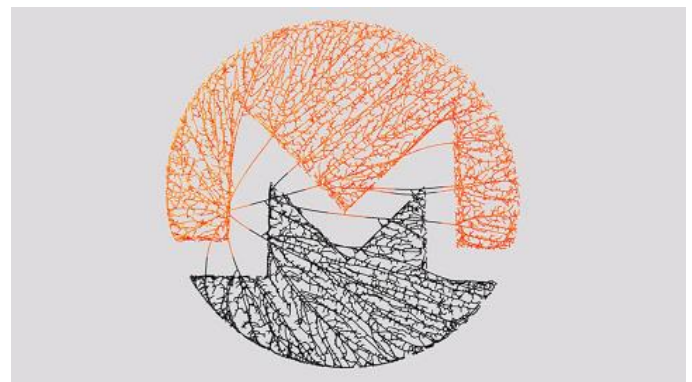
