


THE LATEST

- Congratulations to Monero for breaking the top 10 rankings of most valuable crypto currencies in the world. As of August 28th, the total market cap of Monero is ~\$2.18b, making it the world's 9th most valuable cryptocurrency.
- Congratulations to [r/Monero](#) for breaking 20k subscribers!
- After a week of uncertainty, Monero finally [began trading on Bithumb](#) as of August 27th. XMR briefly traded over \$200 before settling in around the \$140-\$150 range. To celebrate the listing, Bithumb is hosting a Monero top trader event the weekend of September 2nd - 3rd and will award the top 50 traders with XMR, with 1st place taking home 100 XMR.
- [LocalMonero.co](#) was launched last week. The website is a person-to-person trading platform dedicated exclusively to Monero.
- Fortune reported on August 22nd that the [IRS has special software to find Bitcoin tax cheats](#). Fortune says that Bitcoin is less secret than people think and that the IRS is paying a company called Chainalysis to help identify the owners of digital "wallets". Chainalysis says the company has information on 25% of all Bitcoin addresses. Fortune goes on to say that some Bitcoin users are thinking of switching to other digital currencies like Monero that are harder to trace. Increased demand for privacy should continue to lead to positive momentum for Monero.

- The admin of Bitmixer.io, the largest Bitcoin mixing service which recently closed, recommended Monero on August 22nd, "[After the deep investigation I confirm that MONERO is the best privacy currency. So I strongly recommend MONERO for all people who need extra privacy.](#)"

- On the topic of privacy and being anonymous, MIT Technology Review issued a new study on August 23rd claiming that [Bitcoin transactions aren't as anonymous as everyone hoped](#). This is due to web merchants routinely leaking data about purchases. And that can make it straightforward to link individuals with their Bitcoin purchases.

- The chart below was taken from CoinDesk. While Monero came in at #2, the fact that Bitcoin came in at #1 proves that the general crypto community is still largely unaware of the lack-of privacy traits Bitcoin actually possess and what Monero brings to the table.



- [Monerotrader.net](#) was launched on August 22nd. Monerotrader.net is hoping to provide a service similar to Shapeshift, allowing you to convert XMR to and from BTC. See [reddit discussion](#) for more info.

- Huffington Post [released an article on August 24th](#) where “10 top cryptocurrency investors” shared their favorite long-term picks. Monero appeared twice on the list.

• [Monero was discussed in a Forbes Article](#) on August 26th, discussing how Monero price hit an all-time high, pushing higher as the privacy-oriented digital currency continued to benefit from its recent listing on Korean exchange Bithumb.

• A [new episode of the Monero Monitor](#) was released on August 28th. The episode talks about Bithumb adding Monero to their exchange, the debut of LocalMonero.co, Globee's ninja launch, RuffCT, the IRS tracing 50% of all Bitcoin transactions, Taylor Swift's new single, and lots more.

• The Crypto Current [discussed Monero](#) on August 26th. Good discussion on what to watch out for when analyzing the crypto space today.

• [Android Wallet: Monerujo “Silver Bharal”, point release 2](#) was announced on August 22nd. It's a stable release with all necessary functions for day-to-day Monero fun. Spending is still restricted to testnet until more community testing has happened.

• SamsungGalaxyPlayer posted a fantastic [Monero guide](#) on reddit on August 22nd for new members of the community.

• Phloating Man released an in-depth [beginners guide on how to use Monero from a Live USB](#) last week.


• Reddit user [u/zhizhongzhiwai translated the Monero Presentation in Simplified Chinese](#) on August 24th.
