

## THE LATEST

• Congratulations to Monero for surpassing \$3b in market cap and a price of over \$200 per Monero! Both the development and price of Monero has grown a tremendous amount throughout 2017 (which was ~\$188m in market cap and a price of ~\$14 per Monero at the beginning of the year). While we can spend all day recapping 2017, I'm more excited about what's in store for the future of Monero. • In a Infowars interview, [John McAfee claims that if Bitcoin does have a serious competitor, it will be Monero.](#) McAfee noted that that dark web is where first Bitcoin got its use and that it is has currently chosen to use Monero due to its

anonymity and privacy features. He claims that what starts in the dark web will leak out into the world of light as he believes that all people would like to have anonymity and privacy in terms of their financial transactions.



• Monero Dev Meeting summary and logs for December 3<sup>rd</sup> are now available. The most exciting updates are that bulletproofs, which will reduce transactions by ~85% - 90% and therefore will also reduce fees, could be released in September. Additionally, MultiSig is expected to be including in the next release. See highlights below.

- The MRL (Monero Research Lab) has working Java test code for multi-output bulletproofs: i) Currently being ported to C++ (non-multi-output), ii) Research is ongoing for how fee structures are impacted (a large number of outputs could form a Denial of Service), iii) A Single output BulletProof(BP) is 704 bytes - and a 2 output is ~768 bytes. For comparison, single and double outputs in the current version of Monero are 6k and 12k, respectively, iv) In testing, most BulletProof transactions average about 2.2k, v) **BulletProofs may make the September 2018 fork**, vi) A testnet build might be ready within a week.

- A code freeze is scheduled for the end of this month (Dec 2017).

- Surae Noether is completing his review of Monero's MultiSig implementation.

- MultiSig is expected to be included in the freeze (so it will be in the next release): If you're interested in the development aspect or code review for MultiSig, \*now\* is the time to look.

-ZeroMQ(0MQ) is also expected to be in the next release. But at this point there are still some features missing.

- Research continues into switching Monero's Random Number Generator(RNG) to one of Bitcoin's.

• In what is to be an eye-opening case of “Should Have Used Monero”, News.Bitcoin.com reported that [three Kenyans face felony charges for selling bitcoin to a bank robber](#). The article highlights that “one of the fundamental aspects of money is that its origins are irrelevant for its use or value (Pecunia non olet), also called fungibility. Simply put, one shouldn’t face charges if someone used ill-gotten funds to buy something from oneself. This principal is now under question in Kenya where three bitcoin traders have gotten into trouble with the law for unknowingly dealing with an alleged criminal.” This wouldn’t be an issue if the parties transacted with a cryptocurrency that is anonymous and fungible such as Monero.




